

Patient Protocol for your Office Visit

We hope that everyone has been healthy and doing well. Our office is planning on re-opening on June 1, 2020. To ensure you and your family's safety, we have implemented stringent safety measures in place. Additional information can be found on the COVID 19 Dental Update.

So here are just a few things to expect for your next visit and what we are doing to keep you and our staff safe:

- Pre-screening questions of patient. Please reschedule if you have any of the following:
 - If you have any fever or flu like symptoms:
 - If you have traveled by airplane within 14 days
 - Contact with any positive or possible diagnosed COVID -19 person in the last 14 days.
- We will be monitoring the amount of people in the waiting room to comply with social distancing measures. Upon arrival please call us from your car and we will inform you if we are ready for your visit. You may have the option of waiting in your car or if room is available to wait in the waiting room.
- Touchless temporal thermometer readings will be recorded when you enter.
- Staff's temperature will be measured before working and must be below 100.4 degrees F to work.
- All outerwear (jackets, sweaters, coats) must remain in the waiting room or in your car.
- Universal masking will be required in the office. Please wear a mask when entering and in waiting room.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the office. However, you will be asked to wash your hands in the restroom before treatment.
- Please limit to only one parent or guardian per child for visits. Please refrain from bringing more than 1 family member to the office unless necessary.
- Magazines and brochures have been removed from the waiting room.
- Doors will be propped open.

With these assurances, we hope you don't delay making an appointment.
